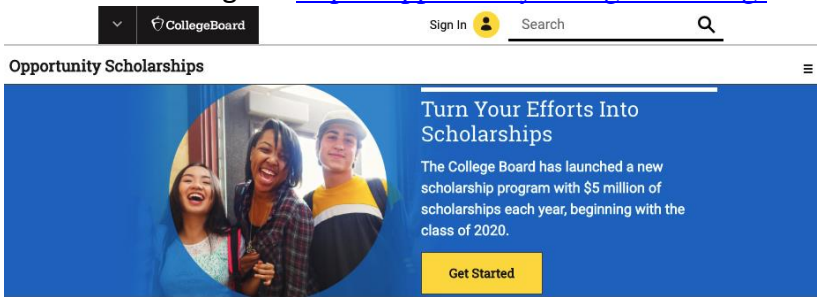


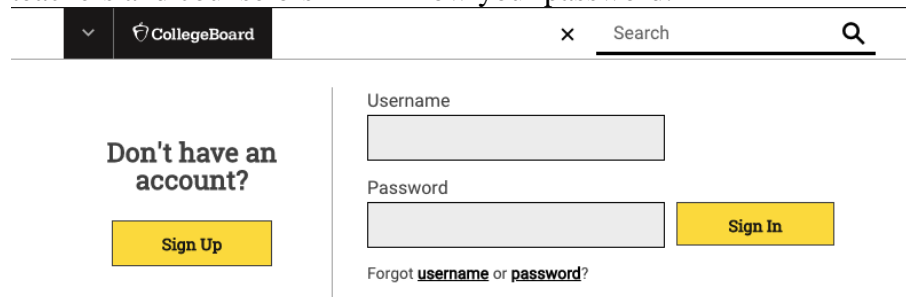
College Board Opportunity Scholarship- Set Up Directions

1. Students go to <https://opportunity.collegeboard.org/>

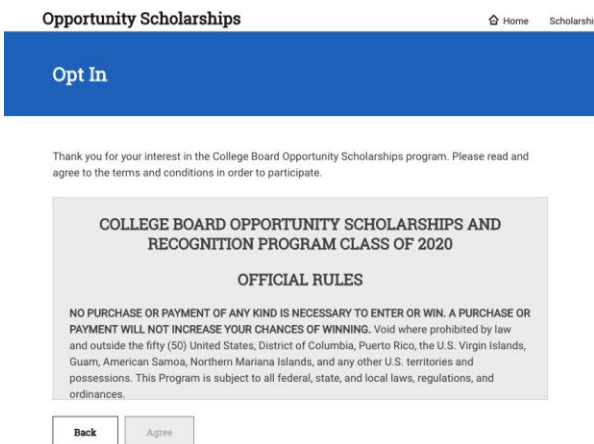


2. Student must sign on to their College Board account or create a new one if they have not already.

Note: Most students created this account in middle school. If you cannot remember your username or password try the “Forgot username or password” button first and try to recover your old account. If you still cannot access, call College Board at their 800 #, they are able to help. If this still doesn’t work, then you can create a new one but your SAT scores probably won’t appear there until you call College Board again and ask them to merge your accounts. Nobody has access to your account, except you. Your teachers and counselors don’t know your password.



3. Once you are signed on, have students read the official rules and agree to the terms and conditions.



4. The next page will show students their Action Plan for all 6 steps of the College Board Opportunity Scholarships.
